

TERMS & CONDITIONS

By registering for Prudencia Model United Nations, all delegates agree to abide by the following Terms and Conditions set forth by the Secretariat.

DELEGATE FEE AND REFUND POLICY

The delegate fee is strictly non-refundable. By completing the payment, the participant acknowledges that the organization incurs immediate administrative and logistical costs based on registration numbers and therefore refunds cannot be processed under any circumstances.

COMMITTEE AND COUNTRY ALLOCATION

The Secretariat prioritizes early registrants for committee and country preferences; however, early application provides a competitive advantage rather than a guarantee. Final allocations remain at the sole discretion of the Secretariat and are determined through a holistic review of factors including, but not limited to, the delegate's prior Model United Nations experience, time of application, age of the participant, and overall committee balance.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT

To receive a Certificate of Participation or to be considered eligible for conference awards, delegates must attend both days of the conference in full. Failure to meet this requirement, without prior written approval from the Secretariat due to a genuine emergency, will result in the forfeiture of all certificates and awards.

DELEGATE CONDUCT

All delegates are expected to maintain professional and respectful conduct throughout the conference. Any form of harassment, discrimination, intimidation, or disruptive behavior toward fellow delegates, organizers, or venue staff will not be tolerated. The Secretariat reserves the right to issue warnings or remove participants from the conference in cases of misconduct, without any refund of the delegate fee.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Prudencia Model United Nations and the host venue shall not be held liable for the loss, theft, or damage of any personal property including, but not limited to, laptops, tablets, and mobile phones during the conference. Delegates are responsible for safeguarding their belongings at all times.

LIABILITY FOR VENUE PROPERTY

Delegates will be financially responsible for any damage caused to venue property, furniture, equipment, or facilities during the conference. The Secretariat reserves the right to recover the cost of damages from the responsible individual(s).

PHOTOGRAPHY AND MEDIA CONSENT

By participating in the conference, delegates grant permission to Prudencia Model United Nations to photograph, film, or otherwise record their participation. Such media may be used for promotional, marketing, archival, or social media purposes without further consent or compensation.

CONFERENCE SCHEDULE AND STRUCTURAL CHANGES

The Secretariat reserves the right to modify the conference schedule, committee structures, or event programming if required due to logistical considerations or unforeseen circumstances.

FORCE MAJEURE

Prudencia Model United Nations shall not be held responsible for cancellations, postponements, or disruptions resulting from circumstances beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, government regulations, public health emergencies, strikes, civil disturbances, or other force majeure events.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

DRESS CODE

Delegates are expected to adhere to Western or Indian formals throughout the duration of the conference unless otherwise specified by the Secretariat.

REGISTRATION TRANSFER

Delegate registrations are non-transferable unless explicitly approved in writing by the Secretariat prior to the conference.

CONDUCT OUTSIDE COMMITTEE SESSIONS

Delegates are expected to uphold the same standards of professionalism and respectful conduct throughout the entire duration of the conference, including during breaks, informal interactions, and activities outside formal committee sessions within the conference venue. Any behavior that disrupts the conference environment, disrespects other participants, or violates venue policies may result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the Secretariat, including removal from the conference without refund.

SOCIAL MEDIA AND PUBLIC REPRESENTATION

Delegates are encouraged to engage with the conference on social media in a responsible and respectful manner. Participants shall refrain from posting content that misrepresents the conference, discloses confidential committee proceedings where confidentiality is expected, or harms the reputation of Prudencia Model United Nations, its organizers, delegates, or partners. The Secretariat reserves the right to take appropriate action in cases of misuse.

SECRETARIAT AUTHORITY

All decisions made by the Secretariat regarding committee proceedings, delegate allocations, awards, interpretation of conference policies, and enforcement of these Terms and Conditions shall be final and binding.
